In fiscal year 2017, **8** out of the **95** initiatives reporting on policy change focused on a life free from violence.

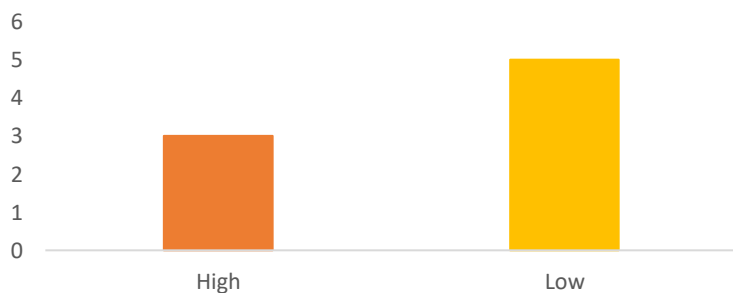


## Advocacy Initiatives by Level



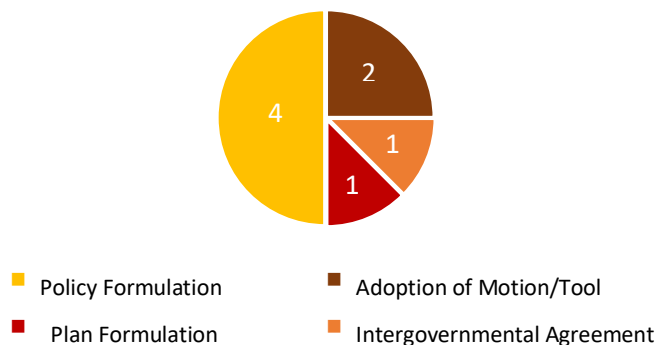
Most life free from violence projects occurred at the **national** level.

## Significance of Advocacy Win



The advocacy wins considered to have **high significance** occurred in **Cambodia, Burundi, and Canada** but a majority were of low significance.
