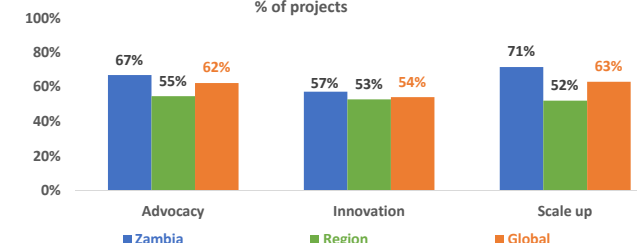

Multiplying Impact % of projects

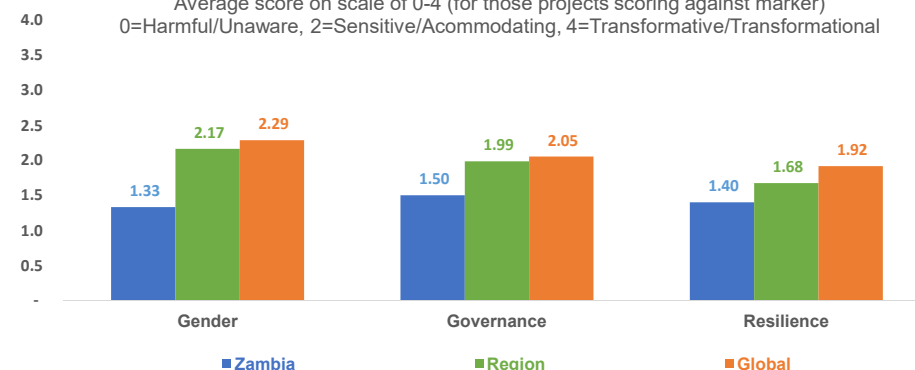

CONTRIBUTIONS TO PROGRAM STRATEGY OUTCOME AREAS

- Reached 0 thousand disaster/crisis-affected people with life-saving humanitarian assistance, indirectly benefiting a further 0 thousand (2 projects/initiatives)
- No projects working on Sexual, Reproductive & Maternal Health rights
- No projects working on the right to a Life Free From Violence
- 159,846** Reached 160 thousand people to support their food and nutrition security and resilience to climate change, indirectly benefiting a further 113 thousand (7 projects/initiatives)
- 14,699** Reached 15 thousand women and girls to promote their access to and control of economic resources, indirectly benefiting a further 62 thousand (2 projects/initiatives)
